## Braggers' Rights Tournament

Saturday and Sunday (Oct 23 & 24)

1. Participants **MUST** check in at Registration before fishing. Waiver must be signed or you will not be allowed to participate in the contest. Registration will open at 7:00 am. We have camping permits for Hale Koa Beach on the Kaneohe Marine Corps Base Hawaii (see directions below). You are welcome to come out on and camp on Friday evening, Oct 22nd to get an early start on Saturday. You must carry your ID and have a life jacket at all times while fishing.
2. Start time is at 7:00 am. Contest ends at 2:00 pm. You need to be back at the registration area by then.
3. Hui Wa'a Kaukahi members entry fee is \$10.00. Non-Hui members, entry fee is \$15.00. Either one includes lunch.
4. You must put in at the beach fronting the registration area, and take out at that same beach. This ensures all fishing is conducted in the same general area.
5. Prizes will be awarded for the largest fish, etc. Most number of fish will not count, so please throw back the little ones. All fish caught can count toward the "Hui Waa Progressive Fishing Contest". See website for more details.
6. Winner of the Grand Prize gets Bragger's Rights, and will be the host of next year's event!
7. All other questions of rulings will be at the sole discretion of the "Tournament Fishmaster".

### **Directions:**

Contact Norman Chun 247-7610 or Tim Sawyer 330-1108 for registration, and provide names, SSN, vehicle make and model, license number by **Oct 19, 2010**. This info will be provided to the front security gate to allow entry on base.

Enter through H-3 gate and check in at the security office. Once processed through, continue on G Street. Turn left on Mokapu Blvd. Continue until you come to the airport runway crossing, then proceed across the runway. Turn left after you cross the runway (Sumner Rd). Continue until you come to another stop sign and proceed with caution. Turn right on Perimeter Road and head toward the ocean, then turn left into Hale Koa beach.

There will be 3 campsites available (15, 16, and 17) and each site will be allowed 2 5-man tents or 10 people per site. So please call Norman Chun to secure a spot. Entry fees must be paid by Oct 19 (Norman will be at our scheduled Tuesday evening meeting) or send check to Norman Chun at 45-410 Ihilani St. Kaneohe, HI 96744. Late entries will be assessed a \$5 late charge.
