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2001:A FISH ODYSSEY aka PROGRESSIVE FISHING TOURNAMENT — 2001

Hui Wa'a Kaukahi is embarking on a new odyssey this year — a progressive fishing tournament starting on January 1, 2001. Charles Ehrhorn will be the "Keeper of the Record" and will track who catches what, where, and how many. Awards for first, second, and third places for the total number of fish caught during the year will be awarded at the Annual Christmas Party. There is a one-time fee of \$5 for members and \$25 for non-members to enter the tournament. Rules include:

- 1. Fish must be over seven (7) inches in length to qualify. (Throw the little ones back into the ocean, please!)
- 2. Fish must be caught on Club-sanctioned outings, including Club-coordinated neighbor island trips.
- 3. Fish must be caught using a line, such as with a rod or a hand line. Catches using spears, nets, explosives, or chemicals are not allowed. Fish jumping into the kayak by itself may count towards your total.
- 4. You must have a witness to your catch. A photograph is better.
- 5. You can return your qualifying fish to the deep as long as you have someone to verify your catch.
- 6. Honor system prevails!

Releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue the American Canoe Association, Inc. or Hui Wa'a Kaukal a nonprofit corporation, its affiliated clubs, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches, and other employees of the organizations, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the events, all of which are hereinafter referred to as "releases", from any and all liability to each of the undersigned, his or her heirs and next of kin for any and all claims, demands, losses, or damages on account of injury, including death or damage to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
