Notes to Paddling Schedule:


- 1. Schedule is subject to change.

- 3. Ratings of the paddles are based on average conditions. Weather and ocean conditions can change rapidly which would increase the difficulty of the paddle. It is up to each individual to assess the conditions prior to launching according to his/her experience and ability, and to decide whether to participate or not.
- 5. A paddle will be cancelled by the leader(s) when there is a Small Craft Advisory or High Surf Advisory.
